## PART A – ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

### SENTINEL SITE: Harbour Breton

- Level II Fish Harvester.
- Head of an enterprise licensed to fish commercially for cod using the gear types designated at the site.
- Licensed to fish for cod in the survey area of the site.
- Harvesters eligible to apply are harvesters from **Harbour Breton**.
- Member in good standing with the FFAW (inshore arrears have to be paid before draw).
- Must be registered with the Professional Fish Harvesters Certification Board.
- Must sign a contract to provide required sentinel services.
- Eligible for an experimental sentinel license issued by Department of Fisheries and Oceans.
- **CONTROL SITE MUST BE FISHED: Harbour Breton 47 22.73N and 55 51.29W. Depth 75-95 fathoms.**

- Vessels **may be** inspected prior to a DFO experimental license being issued.
- Any vessel deemed not suitable will not be eligible to be used.

All fuel and bait costs required for sentinel activities will be reimbursed. Gear expense (nets and trawls) is provided in the annual sum of \$1,200.00 per year. Vessels will be chartered at the following rates:

35 to 39'11"_____	\$425 per day
40' and over_____	\$475 per day
