Last day to submit nomination papers is **February 7, 2022.**

Election Committee reviews nominations and finalizes the list of candidates on **February 28, 2022.**

Ballots to be mailed out to members in good standing on **March 14, 2022.**

Last day for ballots to be received by the Election Office is **April 13, 2022.**

Ballots in the mail picked up on the morning of **April 14, 2022** will also be included.

Ballots will be counted on **April 18, 2022.**

Installation of the new Inshore Council will be **Fall 2022.**

3. THAT I am in compliance with sections 21 and 22 of the *Atlantic Fishery Regulations, 1985* and am not in control of the rights and privileges of a fishing license held in the name of another harvester.
4. THAT I understand that knowingly making a false statement in a sworn affidavit constitutes perjury pursuant to section 131(1) of the *Criminal Code of Canada*.
